Twelve populations of native (green), invasive (red), and naturalised (yellow) status were grown in a field common garden under two nitrate-fertilisation treatments, low (light shade) and high (dark shade) (n = 5–6 per population and fertilisation treatment; for population codes see Table 1). Number of (a) rosette and (c) offshoot leaves per plant in the first year. Number of (b) rosette, (d) offshoot, and (e) stem leaves per plant in the second year.
